

Payment & Fees – Members

These fees are effective as of October 1, 2022. Please note that they are subject to occasional change and the fees applicable will be those in effect on the date of the wedding ceremony.

Base Cost: \$4,500

Included:

- ✘ \$500, Non-Refundable Deposit
- ✘ Use of the Cathedral Sanctuary or Saint Martin’s Chapel for Rehearsal (1.25 hour maximum) + Ceremony and photos (3.75 hour maximum)
- ✘ Wedding Coordinator (the Sacristan)
Communications should be confined to working hours (Sunday through Thursday, 9 am to 4:30 pm). After-hours communications will not be monitored and/or will be billed at \$100/hour.
- ✘ Cathedral Organist (includes one rehearsal)
- ✘ Sound Tech/AV Support
Support is for the wedding ceremony only; reception support is not available.
- ✘ Service Leaflet
- ✘ Couple’s Preparation Rooms

Note: A portion of the wedding fees go to the priest’s discretionary fund and allow the cathedral clergy to provide assistance to the poor and those in need

Additional Costs:

Reception Coordination by the Cathedral Administrator Communications should be confined to working hours (Sunday through Thursday, 9 am to 4:30 pm). After-hours communications will not be monitored and/or will be billed at \$100/hour.	\$750
Kitchen For use by caterer, hired by the wedding couple or family of the couple with the approval of the Cathedral Administrator.	\$500 per 4 hours

Flowers The sacristan will provide a list of approved florists who will invoice the couple directly.	invoiced by florist
Consultation with the Cathedral Organist Hiring an outside musician, such as a soloist.	\$50/hour
Live-streaming of Wedding Ceremony Reception live-streaming is not available.	\$750

Fees for couples wishing to have an offsite ceremony with a member of the cathedral clergy are \$1500 plus the clergy’s travel and lodging for the wedding weekend. A portion of these fees will go to the priest’s discretionary fund.
